1. An annual blind fee of \$25 must be paid prior to permit issuance; an additional annual hunt fee of \$25 will also be assessed for each hunter. The blind holder will receive the option to renew each year. Failure to renew will result in the removal of the blind at the owner's expense.
2. Private blind owners are responsible for the maintenance of their blind. Blinds may be inspected for structural safety at any time. If the blind is deemed unsafe, the owner will be notified and required to repair the structure.
3. Private blinds shall not be constructed within 500 yards of an existing blind, public road or residence. All locations must be pre-approved.
4. Permitted blinds are for the exclusive use of the permit holder. Guests must have written permits.
5. No fee may be charged by the permit holder to hunt blind.
6. Private blinds must be hunted once per season and the permit must be permanently displayed on the outside of the blind.
7. Private blinds are temporarily allowed on City property. The City shall maintain the right to order the blind removed or remove same if it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Rocky Mount. The owner understands and agrees to this stipulation and all conditions, laws and ordinances* as they may apply now or in the future. The City of Rocky Mount will be held harmless for the injury or death of any person using such blind.
8. Please contact the Nash County Planning Office (459-1212) to verify compliance with any regulations under Federal Rule CFR44-60.3 or Nash County Ordinance 12-2.

*Note: Some areas of the Rocky Mount Reservoir are in an area that the Federal Government has listed as "prone to flooding" and may be considered part of the designated floodway. Certain Federal and County Regulations may require compliance if you decide to build a duck blind in the designated floodway and as a result additional costs or fees may be incurred.

Completed applications and the **non-refundable** \$5 lottery fee must be in the Parks and Recreation Administrative office no later than noon, Friday, September 28, 2018. The lottery will be held at noon, Friday, October 5, 2018 in the Parks and Recreation Administration office, applicants do not have to be present.
