

# Please make sure to READ all information on the 2021 Hybrid Senior Games: this year will be different & unique

- 1: The Idea behind our Hybrid Games is that you can participate in DESG completely on your own, while also having the option to participate in person for some events.
- 2: If you choose to participate in person, be prepared to follow the NC COVID-19 governance in place for outdoor gatherings & we will require face masks. DESG will be making safety of the participants and staff our number one priority.
- 3: All in person games will take longer to execute, including multiple days reflected on the calendar. You will receive your event time with your confirmation letter in the mail. No one will receive an event time until registration has been completed.
- 4: Golf & Bowling events will be virtual events only. Participants who wish to compete will: go complete a game/round at whichever course/alley they would like and turn in their scores to DESG before the Deadline of June 4, 2021. \*DESG will not be collecting any extra fees for bowling or golf this year (usually bowling is \$8 per event & golf \$20) instead you will pay the facility directly.
- 5: Unfortunately not all sports can be offered & the following have been cancelled for 2021: Badminton, Billiards & Table Tennis.
- 6: SilverArts participants will have two options to turn in their work, at a drive-thru drop off or by emailing in pictures of their entries. SilverArts will be virtual only-there will be no live performances or gallery this year.
- 7: Everyone Participating will get a virtual games card in the mail. You will put all of your scores or times on this card for VIRTUAL Games & mail it or turn it in on the deadline of June 4, 2021.

# Hybrid DESG

- Anything under Hybrid list means you will choose to participate in person or virtually (on your own). Please pay close attention to the lists provided when registering.
- DESG reserves the right to change or alter (a) sport(s) rules, scoring & execution at this time. Some sports WILL be played differently to ensure safety.
- If you choose to participate in person, <u>we will require face masks</u>. Be prepared to follow the NC COVID-19 governance in place for outdoor gatherings.
- All in person games will take longer to execute- Some events may last hours, you are encouraged to bring your own food, chairs & sanitary items. Some events we may ask you to wait in your vehicles until it is your turn to compete.
- All Event times, facility addresses, virtual score cards and any additional rules, procedures or maps will be included in your Confirmation Letters- No one will receive an event time until registration has been completed.
- Check-in time before events have changed! Check in for all events starts 10 min prior to the start time that is provided with your confirmation letter—we will not check in anyone earlier than 10 min.

### DESG 2021 Policy, Procedures & Rules

#### For Everyone Participating:

- DESG is open to persons 50+: your age as of December 31, 2021 will determine the age category in which you will compete Photo Identification and verification of birthdate are required at each event. We also recommend having personal medical information with you during events in case of emergency.
- Participants must be a North Carolina resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the year
- Competition will be by age and sex divisions as follows: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+
- No event will be delayed for latecomers. Match time is forfeit time. No shows no refunds

#### For Sport Participants:

- In doubles events, the <u>age of the younger player</u> is used to determine age group for competition. In team events, the age of the <u>youngest player on team roster</u> determines age group for competition.
- DESG reserves the right to cancel or combine age groups for any event due to insufficient registration.
- Safety and sportsmanlike conduct are paramount. DESG officials have the authority to disqualify, and/or remove anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior or a condition of medical concern.

#### For SilverArts Participants:

- All entries must be original works of the artist. Work must be created after age 50, and within the last 2 years
- Entries are only eligible for judging or display if they have never been entered in any SilverArts competition before: records are kept and your piece will be disqualified if recognized from past competitions.
- Artist's name and title of the work must appear on, or be attached to the entry for identification

- All items must be dropped off and PICKED UP on the delegated days provided on the events schedule
- Items not picked up after one year will become property of DESG.
